TRICARE Select Changes for Group A Retirees Effective Jan. 1, 2021




Congress directed the Defense Health Agency to implement TRICARE Select Group A retiree enrollment fees in the 2017 National Defense Authorization Act.

- Effective Jan. 1, 2021, most Group A retired beneficiaries will be required to pay TRICARE Select enrollment fees. Group A are defined as all beneficiaries whose sponsors initially enlisted or was appointed in a Uniformed Service before Jan. 1, 2018.
- About 1.2 million retirees and family members were automatically enrolled in TRICARE Select on Jan. 1, 2018, when TRICARE Standard ended (no enrollment fees required at that time).
- Group B, initially enlisted or appointed on or after Jan. 1, 2018, already pay enrollment fees.







TRICARE Select Changes for Group A Retirees Effective Jan. 1, 2021



| | Prior to Jan. 1, 2021 | Eff. Jan. 1, 2021 |
|---|-----------------------|--------------------|
| Enrollment Fee (Per Month) Individual Two or More | \$0 \$0 | \$12.50 \$25.00 |
| Deductible (Annual) Individual Family | \$150 \$300 | \$150 \$300 |
| Family Catastrophic Cap (Annual) | \$3,000 | \$3,500 |

Note: Rates as of Jan. 1, 2021 are annually adjusted by the retiree cost of living allowance

- These TRICARE Select changes do not apply to:
 - ☐ Retirees medically retired from a Uniformed Service (10 U.S.C. Chapter 61) and family members
 - ☐ Survivors of members who die while on active duty

Key Points



- Group A retirees and family members must establish a TRICARE Select fee payment plan through their regional contractor, to start on Jan. 1, 2021.
 - Establishing an enrollment fee payment via monthly allotment through a defense pay center is required, where feasible.
 - Payment via EFT/credit/debit account is allowed.
- Failure to establish a payment plan before Jan. 1, 2021, requires termination of existing
 TRICARE Select coverage effective December 31, 2020.
- Those disenrolled will receive a disenrollment letter and instructions how to reinstate
 TRICARE Select coverage within 180 days of disenrollment.
- Beneficiaries who fail to reinstate coverage within 180 days will only be authorized care at a military medical treatment facilities on a space-available basis.
- Re-enrollment is only possible during the following Open Season or if a member of the family experiences a Qualifying Life Event.

TRICARE Open Season



Open Season Begins Nov. 9 and runs through Dec. 14, 2020

What's Different This Year?

There is a call to action! Most Group A retirees currently enrolled in TRICARE Select must:

- Enroll in or change health plans during Open Season.
 - Even if you're already enrolled in TRICARE Select, you need to take action.
- Establish enrollment-fee payment through allotment, where feasible, via EFT, credit, or debit-card withdrawal.

NOTE: Group A retirees currently enrolled in TRICARE Select cannot set up an allotment through Beneficiary Web Enrollment (BWE). Contact your regional contractor to provide your fee payment information (see following slides for contact information).



Keep DEERS Up to Date!



- All TRICARE eligibility is based on the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System, or DEERS.
- Being able to use TRICARE depends on you keeping your information up to date in DEERS. Learn more at https://www.tricare.mil/deers.
- Use these options to update your information in DEERS:
